Notes to Candidates for Scholarship

The Fallenstein Scholarship Program has been established to provide students who excel academically, are outstanding leaders in their communities and have financial need, the opportunity to attend Loyola Catholic School. This scholarship has the potential to cover most or all of the student's tuition needs. Students who receive this scholarship will continue to be sponsored until graduation, provided they meet the scholarship guidelines and complete a yearly written essay explaining their experience at Loyola Catholic School.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Only applications submitted directly to Loyola Catholic Schools Finance Office will be accepted. Applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Have a demonstrated need verified by a completed SmartAid financial aid application; financial aid application fees will be covered by donor (must turn in a completed scholarship application form to get code)
- Have and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA/be in good academic standing
- Not be currently attending Loyola Catholic School
- Be willing to attend an interview with donor upon request

Once awarded the Fallenstein Scholarship, students must maintain the above guidelines and submit an essay detailing their experience and why they value Loyola Catholic School in January of each year to continue their sponsorship. Current recipients do **NOT** need to fill out the Fallenstein Application form to continue their sponsorship. The Fallenstein Scholarship Program reserves the right to discontinue sponsorship at anytime, provided the above guidelines are not met or they are no longer able to fund the program.
