

# Photography I

## Course Requirements:

- Picture Write-ups:** Students will use their computers to find 40 quality photographs from a respected web site such as National Geographic online (or other reputable publications) with explanations of the elements and principles of design as well as descriptions of photographic elements. The pictures are to be copied from site, pasted into document, and completed with typed descriptions. These are to be sent to Mr. Compton in the following format:  
Studentname\_wu1.doc and then placed in my drop box on the server (shared → all → t-compton23 → drop box).
- Journal:** This should be a daily/weekly project. Content should reflect what was done in class and in the darkroom as far as what was learned. Your entries should also include your successes and failures, your experiences with shooting, developing film, printing pictures, use of chemicals, darkroom procedures, etc. This is not merely a log, but a journal of thoughts and reflections. This is to be typed and sent to me in the following format:  
Studentname\_j1.doc and then placed in my drop box on the server (shared → all → t-compton23 → drop box).
- Photographs:** Eight 8x10 enlargements, technically perfect (in focus, clean, no dust/scratches, good borders). These prints should be your best work. Check with instructor to help you make critical decisions about your photos.
- Binder Cover:** Design a cover for your photography binder. Be creative and use a photo theme.
